# FACULTY EXCHANGE

- Visiting scholars from the Caribbean Program, in different areas of business administration, to be implemented in the International Commerce PhD Program of the Business Administration Faculty of the Río Piedras Campus.
- Collaborative Agreement on faculty exchange between member Universities of UNICA and the General Studies Faculty of the Río Piedras Campus.
- Faculty exchange and development of collaborative projects between universities in the Caribbean Area and the Pharmacy School of the Medical Sciences Campus.
- Strengthen the nursing curriculum in the areas of Pediatric Nursing, Obstetrics, Mental Health and Psychiatry, Adult and Elderly Medicine and Surgery, Intensive Care: Coordinate faculty training and exchange with the Universidad Autónoma de Santo Domingo and the Nursing School of the Medical Sciences Campus.
- Promote joint research projects between professors of the Universities in the Caribbean and professors and the Engineering College of the Mayagüez Campus.
- Faculty exchange in the areas of Caribbean Environmental Law and International Environmental Law between the University of the West Indies and the Law School at the Río Piedras Campus.
